INTRODUCTION

Winona Tong is an artist whose practice explores how systems and structures shape the construction and perception of identity. Her work examines processes of classification, regulation, and erasure, investigating how the self is mediated through external frameworks and authorised forms of representation. Through strategies of layering, fragmentation, and reconstruction, she recontextualises documents, symbols, and traces of lived experience to reflect on identity as fluid and continually negotiated. Engaging with the tension between personal subjectivity and institutional narratives, Winona's practice considers the fragility of selfhood and the ways power, memory, and perception intersect to influence how individuals are defined, recognised, and understood.
